

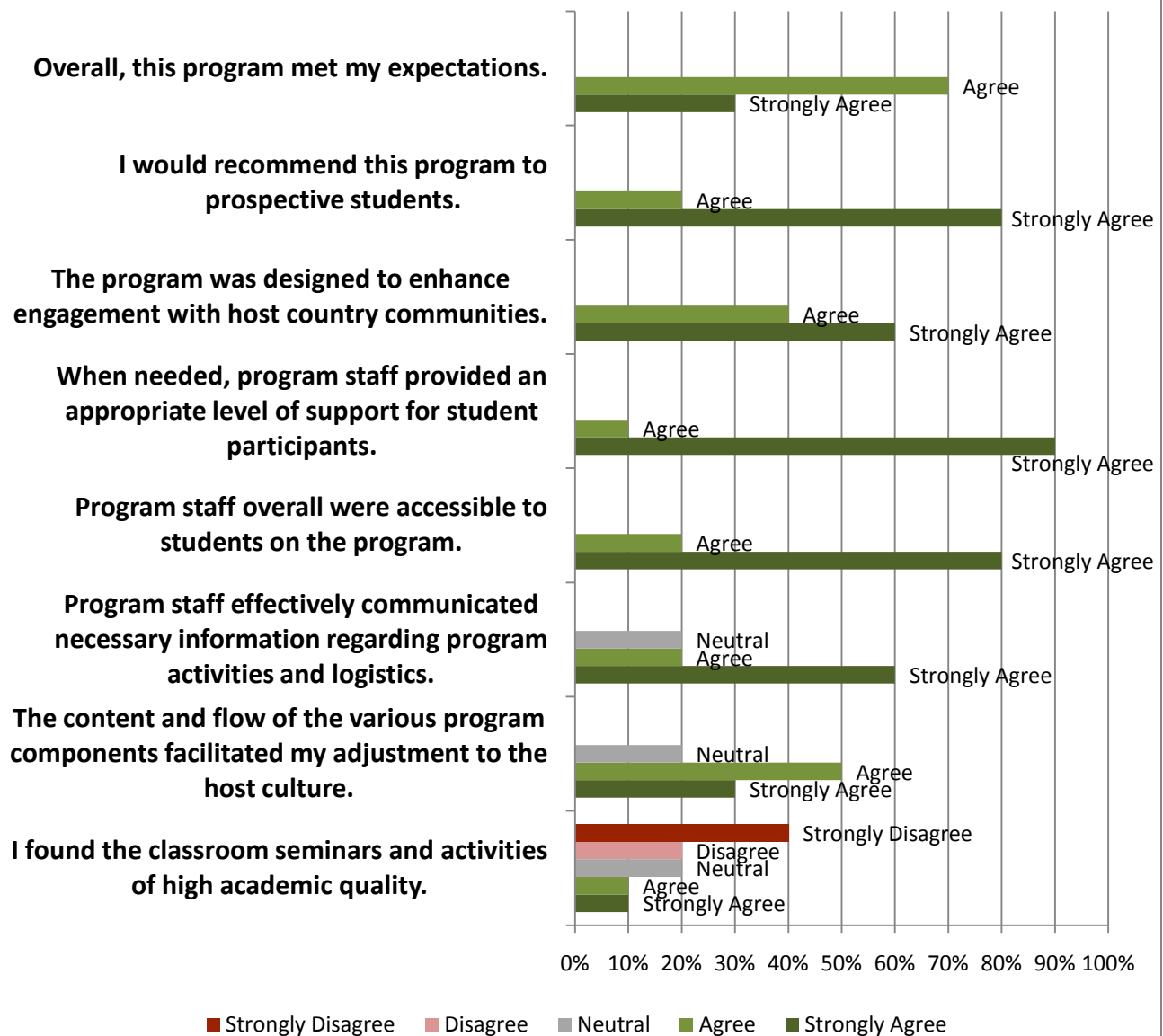

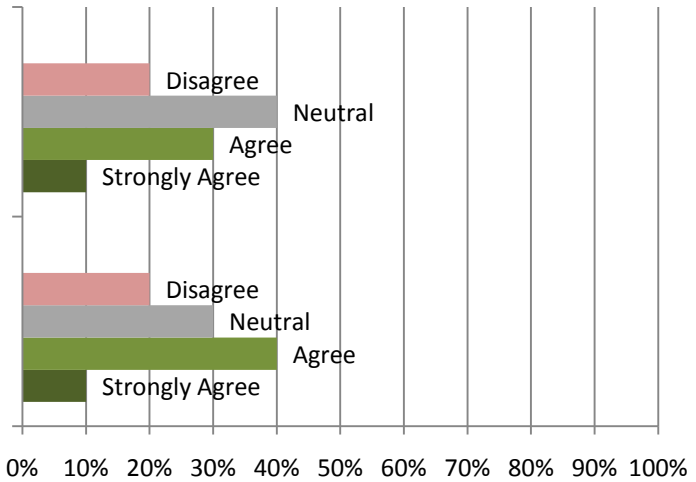

Overall Program Assessment

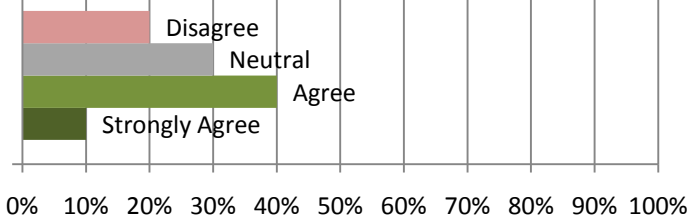


Overall Academic Quality

Academic assignments enhanced my knowledge and understanding of the host culture.



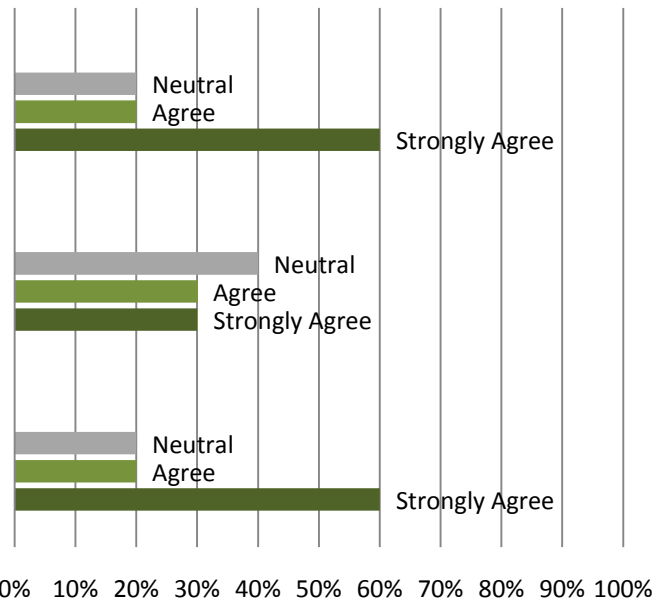
The assignments during the term effectively advanced my knowledge of the theme of the program.



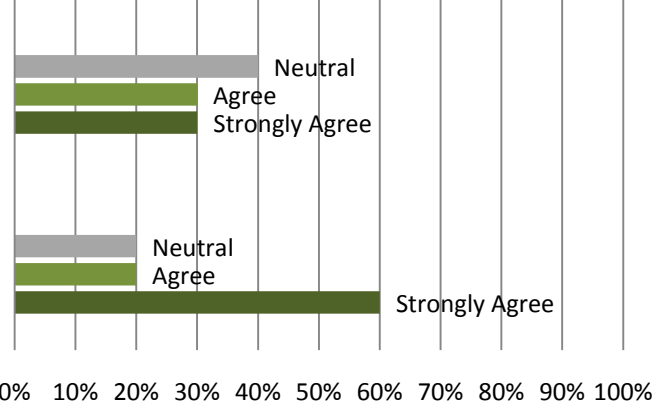

Language Instruction

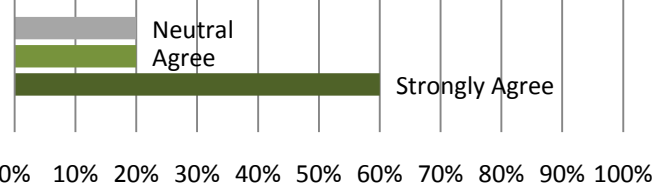
I gained enough skill and confidence from the language instruction to participate productively in the culture.

The language teaching was effective in strengthening my conversational competence.



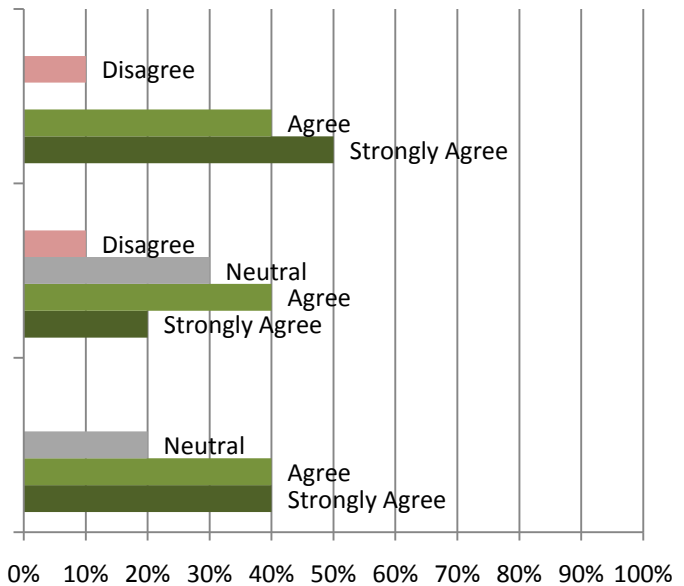

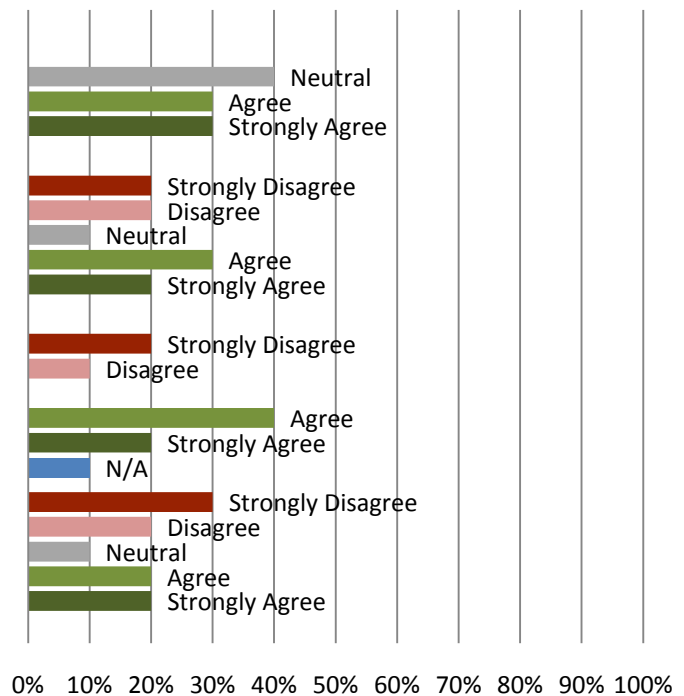
Field Study Seminar

The Field Study Seminar introduced me to useful tools that helped me better navigate local cultural norms.

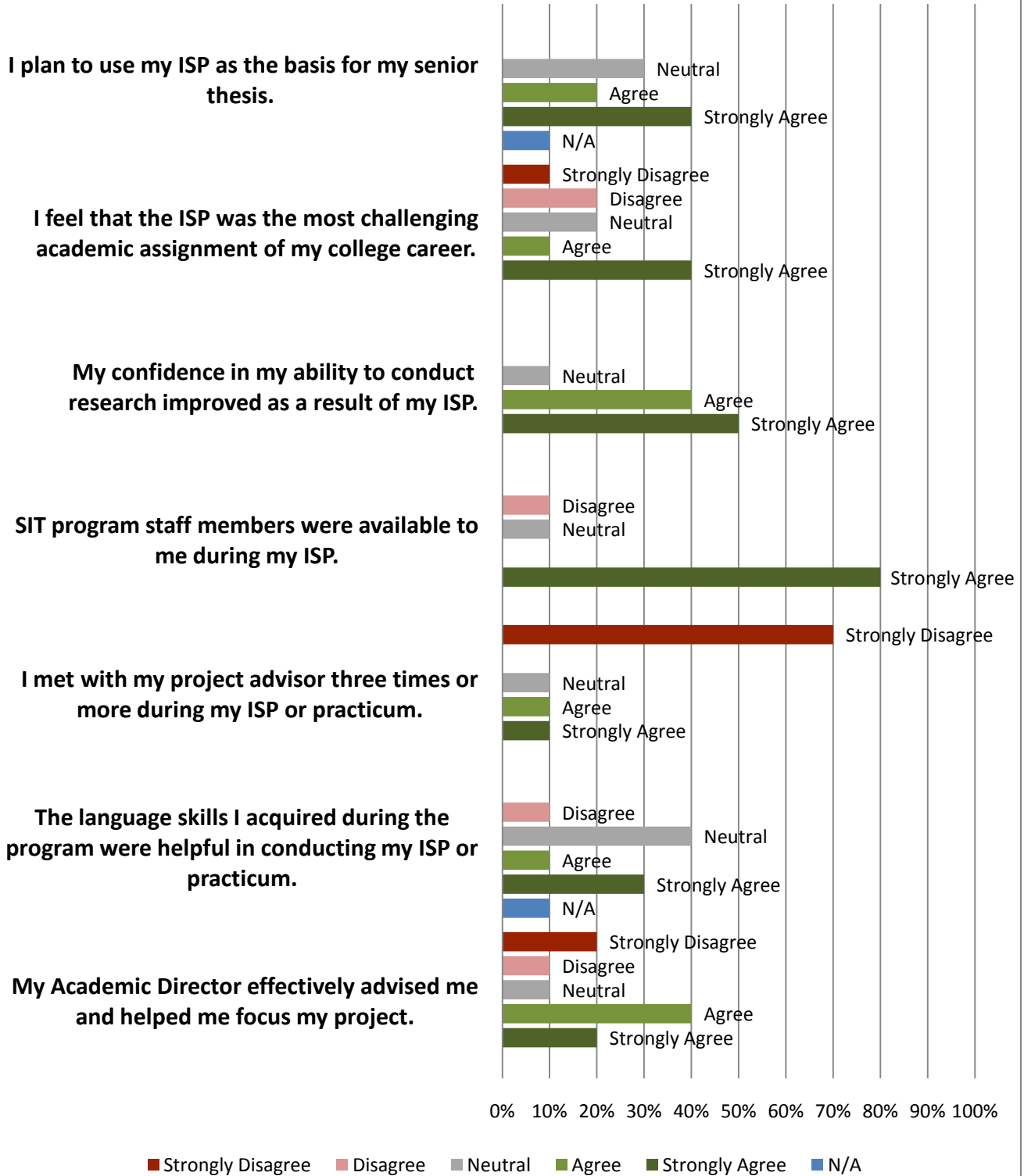
I used field study methods learned in this Seminar to do class assignments and conduct my Independent Study Project.

The Field Study Seminar prepared me to begin my Independent Study Project.



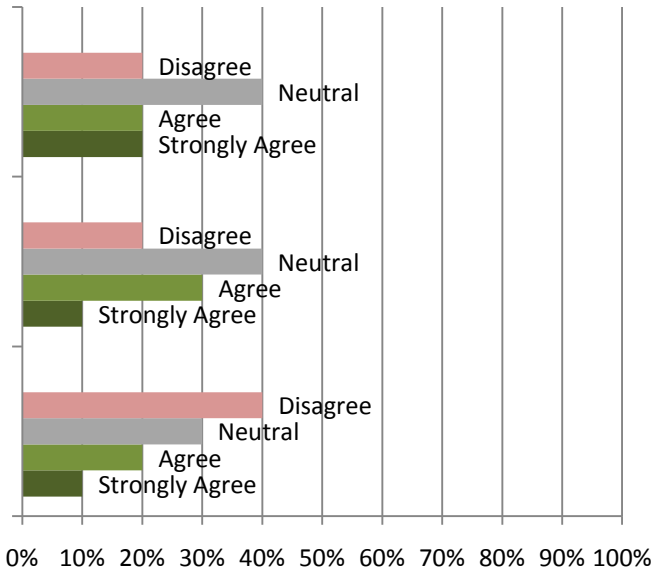

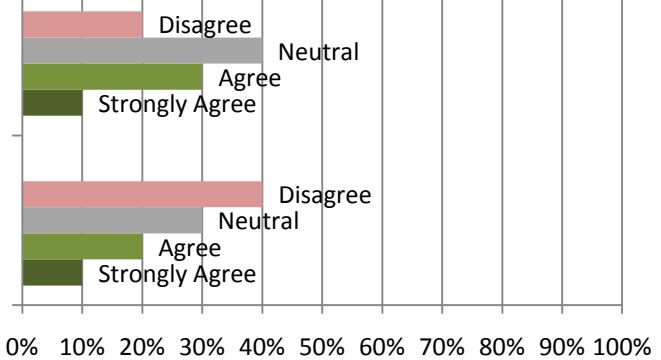

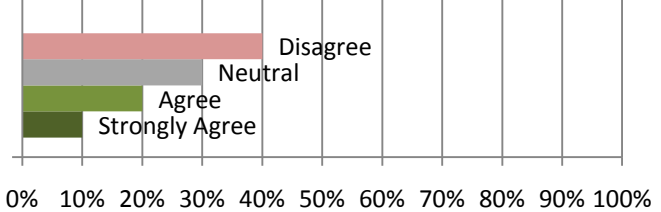
The thematic seminar provided a strong foundation for successful field-based learning in the country.



The thematic seminar successfully integrated the diverse aspects of the program content.



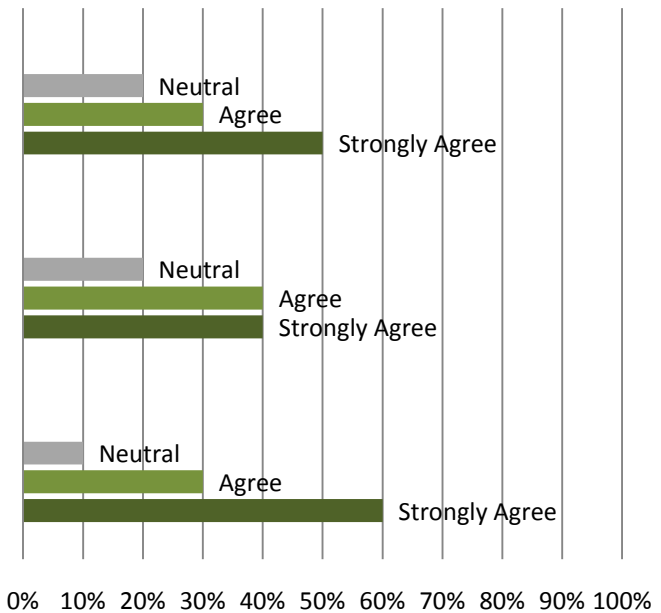
The thematic seminar provided high quality academic content related to the program theme.



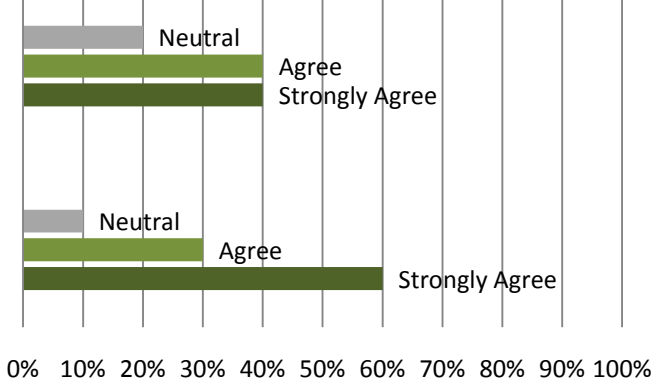

Homestay(s)

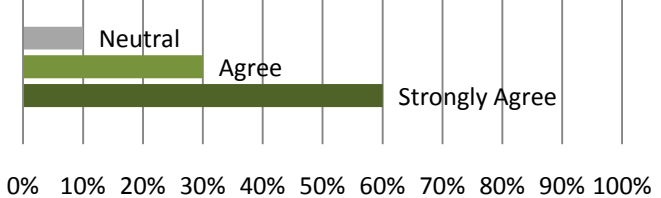
The homestay experience helped me improve my use of the local language.



The homestay experience helped me integrate with the daily life of a local family.



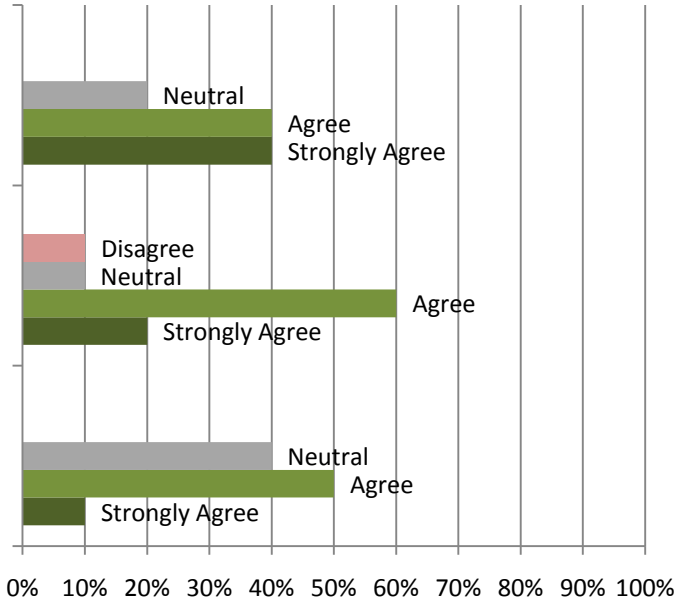
The homestay experience increased my understanding of the culture.

Orientation

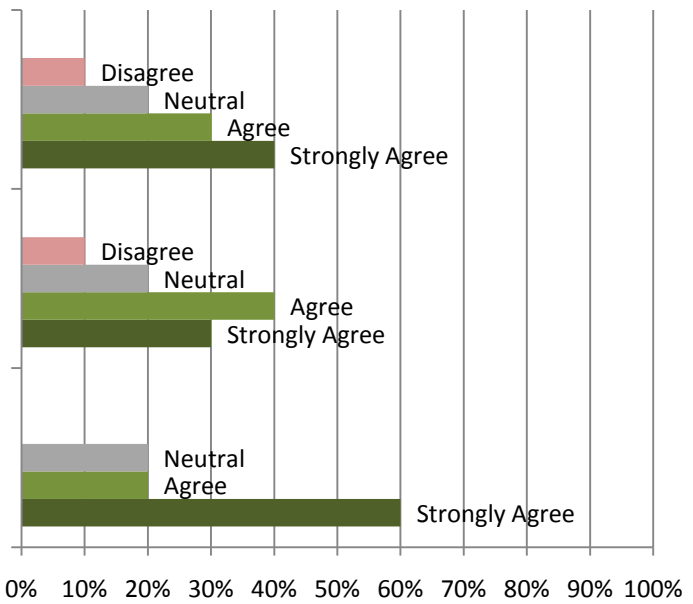
The orientation was effective in helping me understand SIT student health & safety policies, program regulations, and disciplinary rules.
