

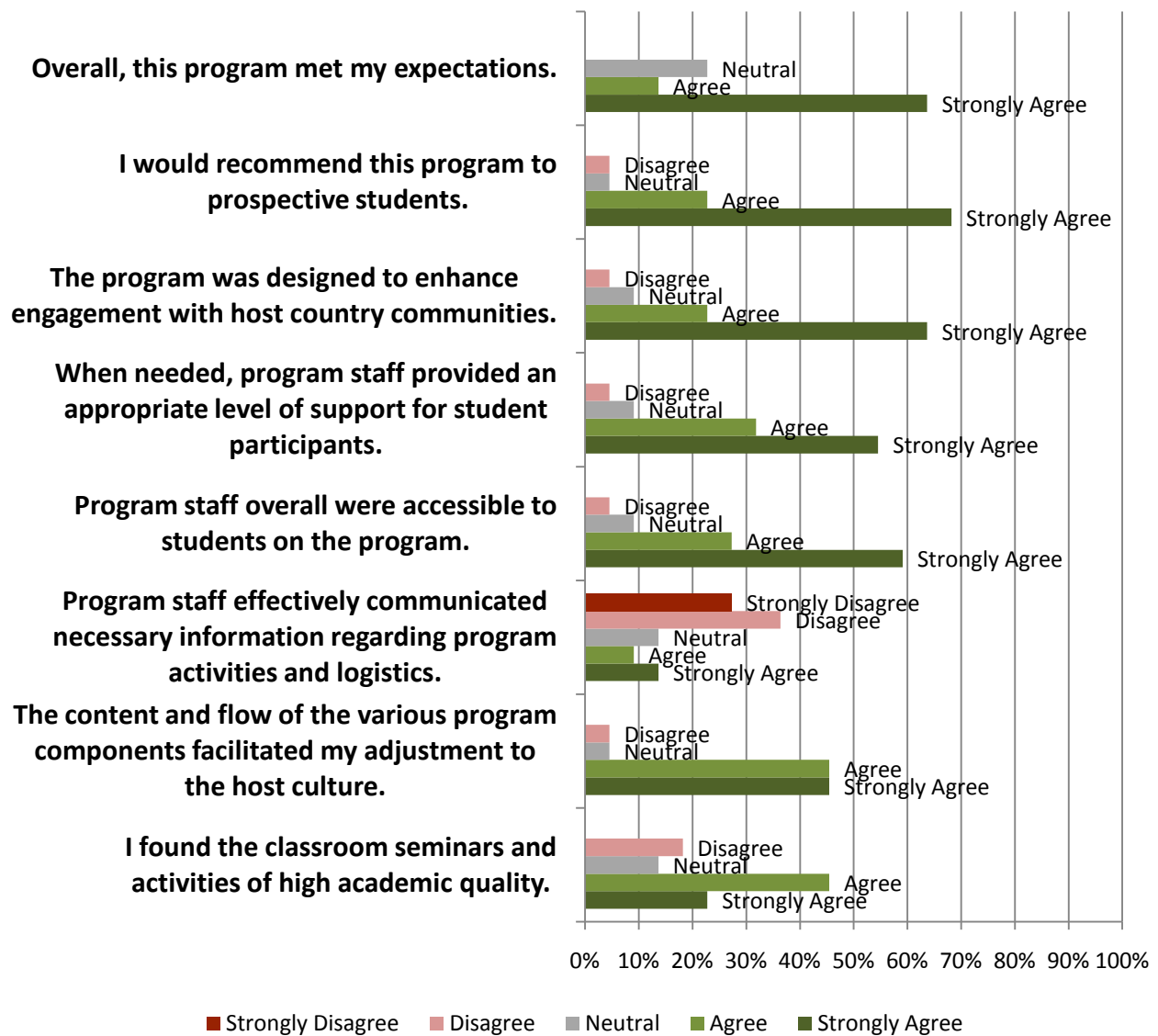

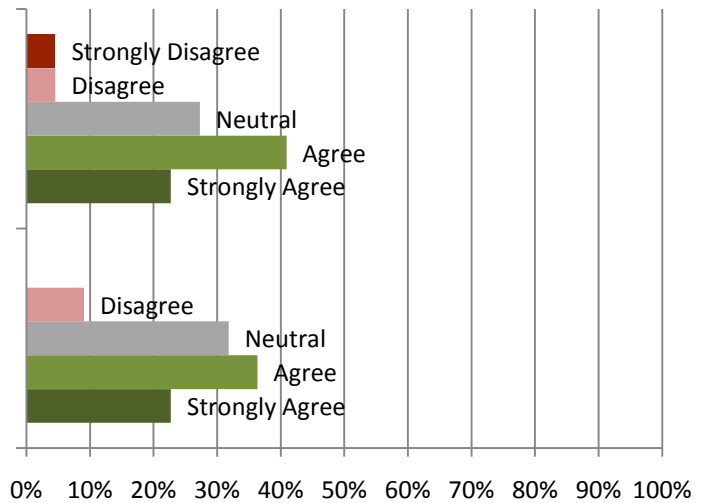
Overall Program Assessment

The assignments during the term effectively advanced my knowledge of the theme of the program.



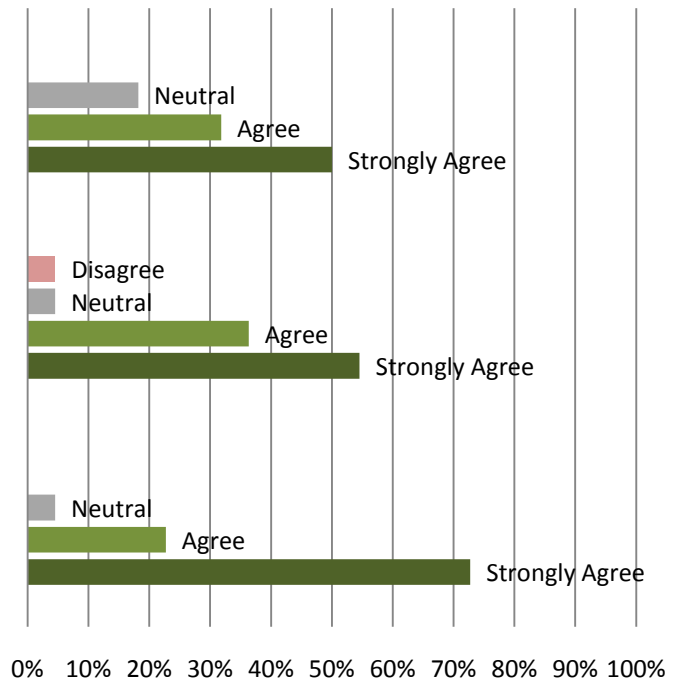

The language teaching was effective in strengthening my conversational competence.



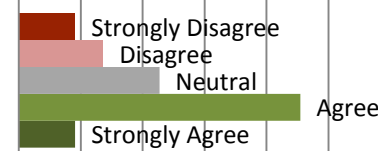

Educational Excursions

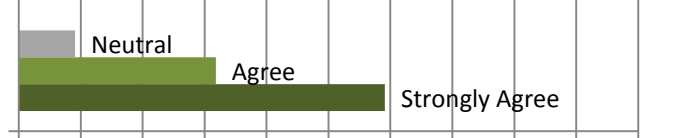
The educational excursions helped me better understand the culture of the host country and the program theme.

The excursions complemented the other educational activities of the program.

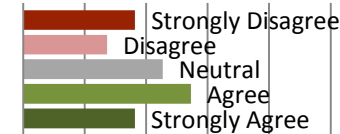

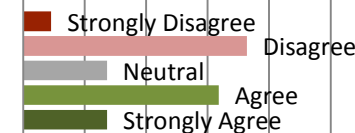

Field Study Seminar

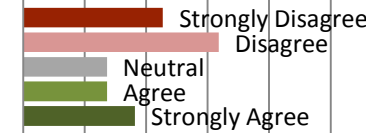
I was fully informed about SIT's Human Subjects Review Policy, the Local Review Board, and SIT's guidelines for conducting ethical research.



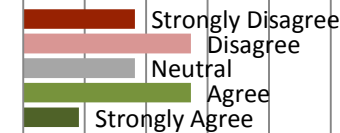
The Field Study Seminar introduced me to useful tools that helped me better navigate local cultural norms.



I used field study methods learned in this Seminar to do class assignments and conduct my Independent Study Project.



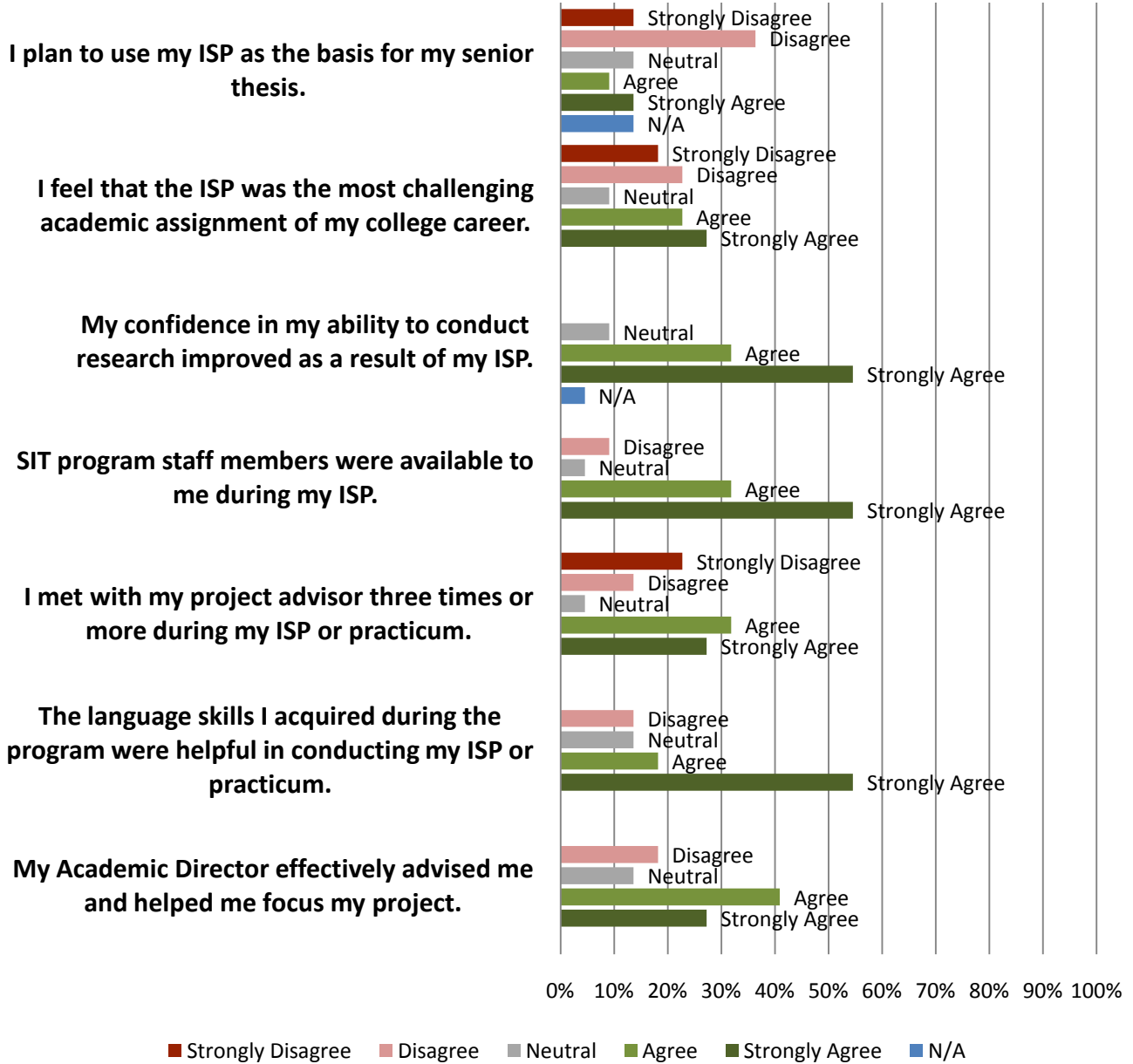
The Field Study Seminar prepared me to begin my Independent Study Project.



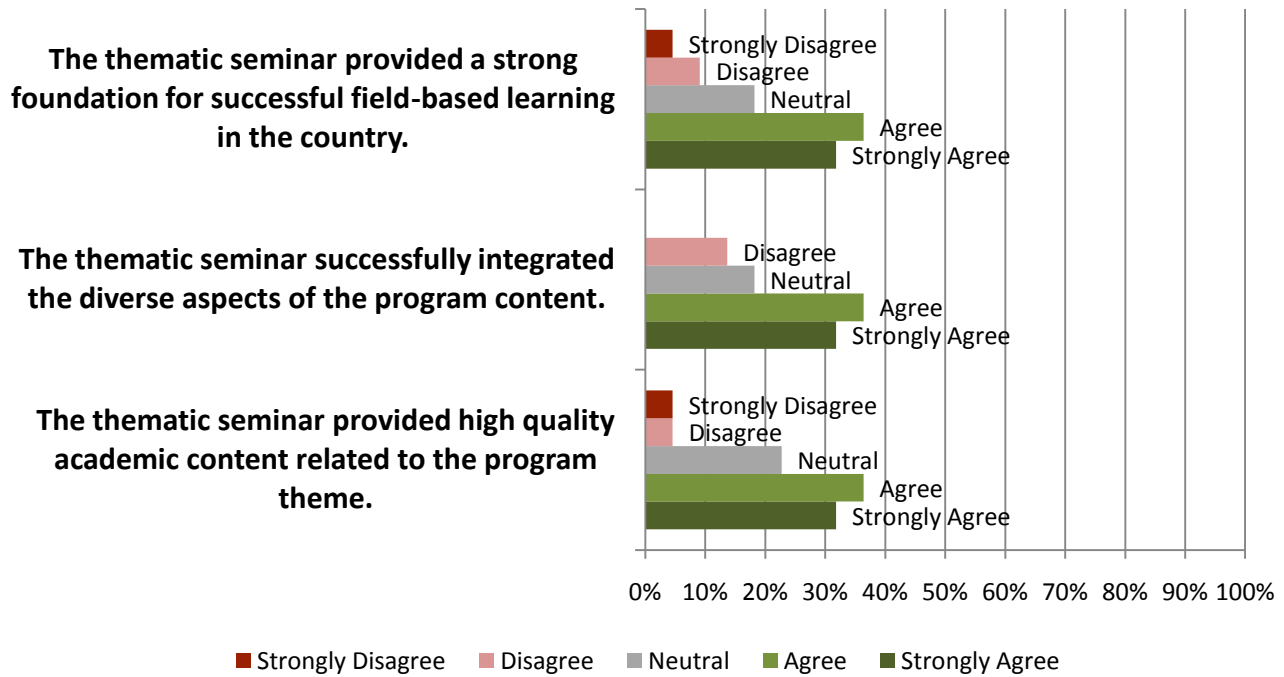

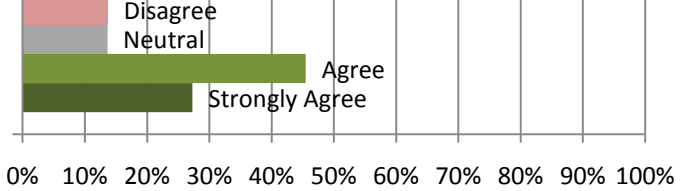
The orientation was effective in helping me understand SIT student health & safety policies, program regulations, and disciplinary rules.



The orientation was effective in helping me understand the program's academic objectives, expectations, and grading policies.



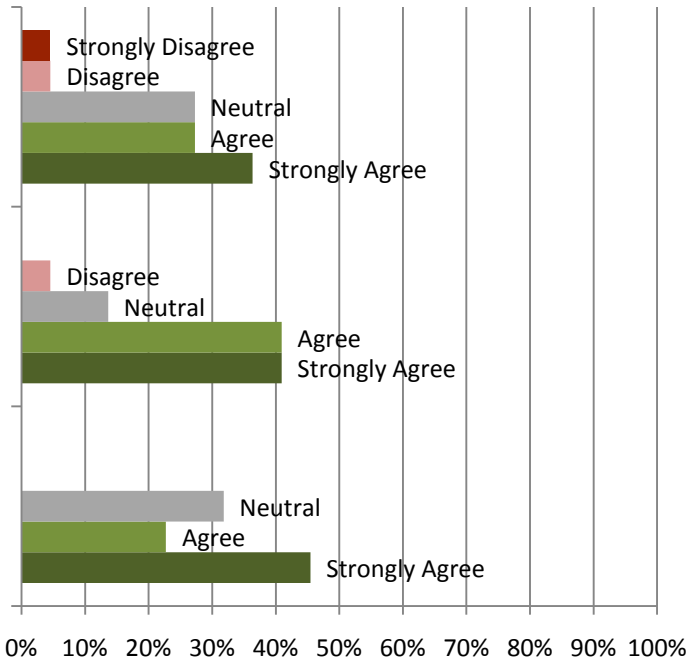
The orientation was effective in providing an understanding of the country context.



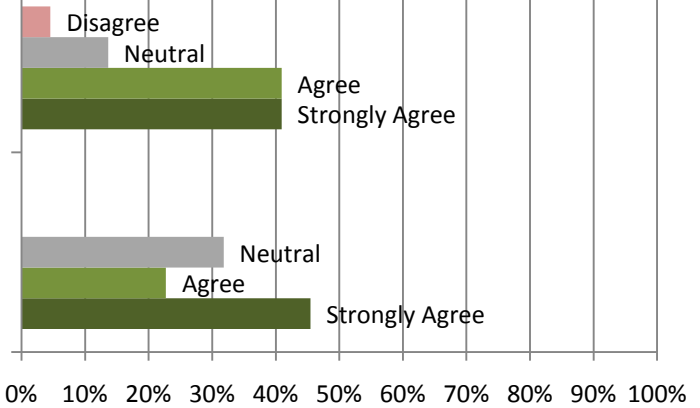

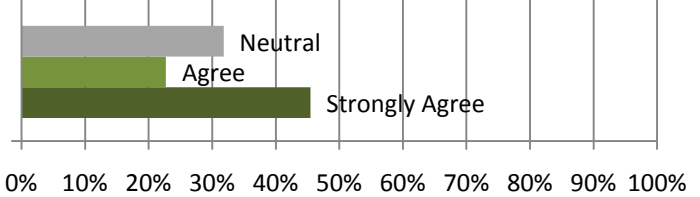
The print material about SIT Study Abroad clearly explained the content of the program.
