



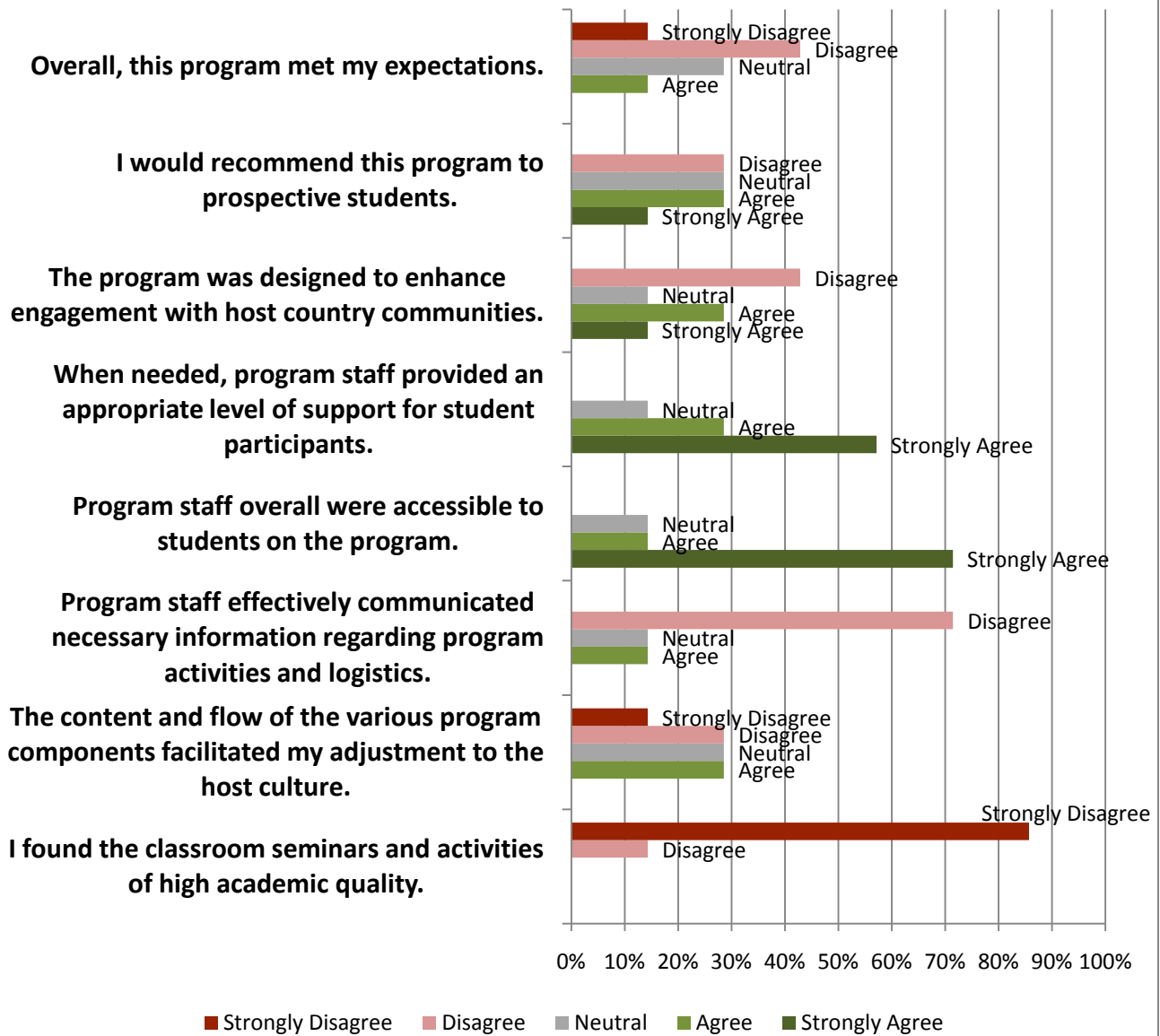

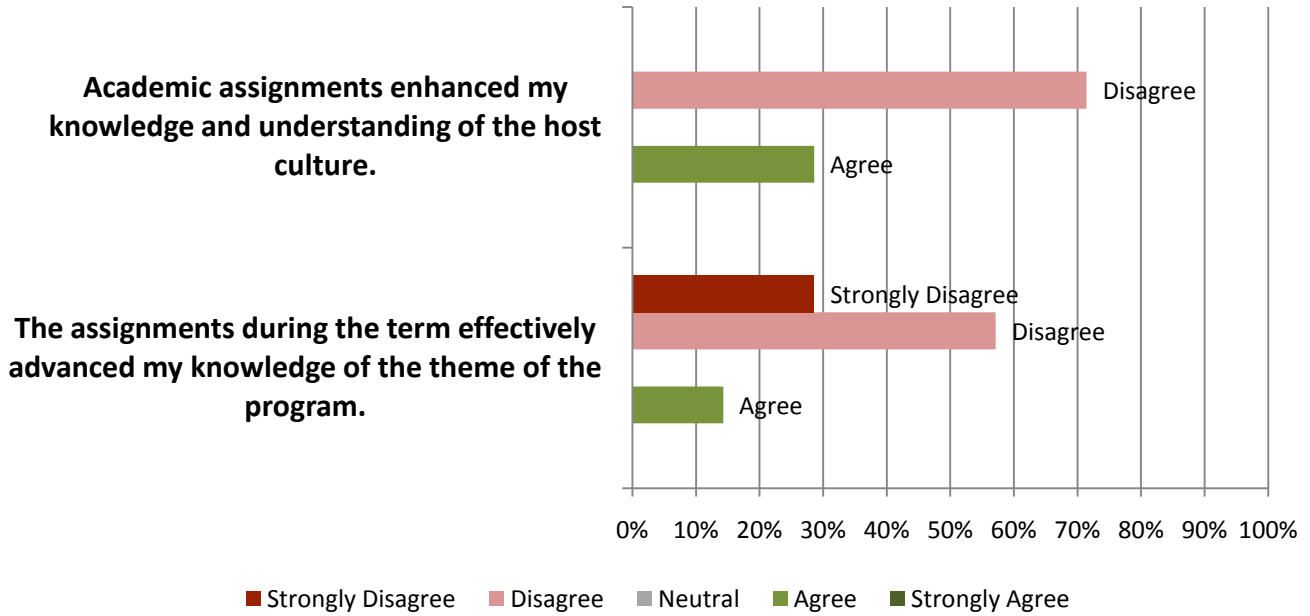

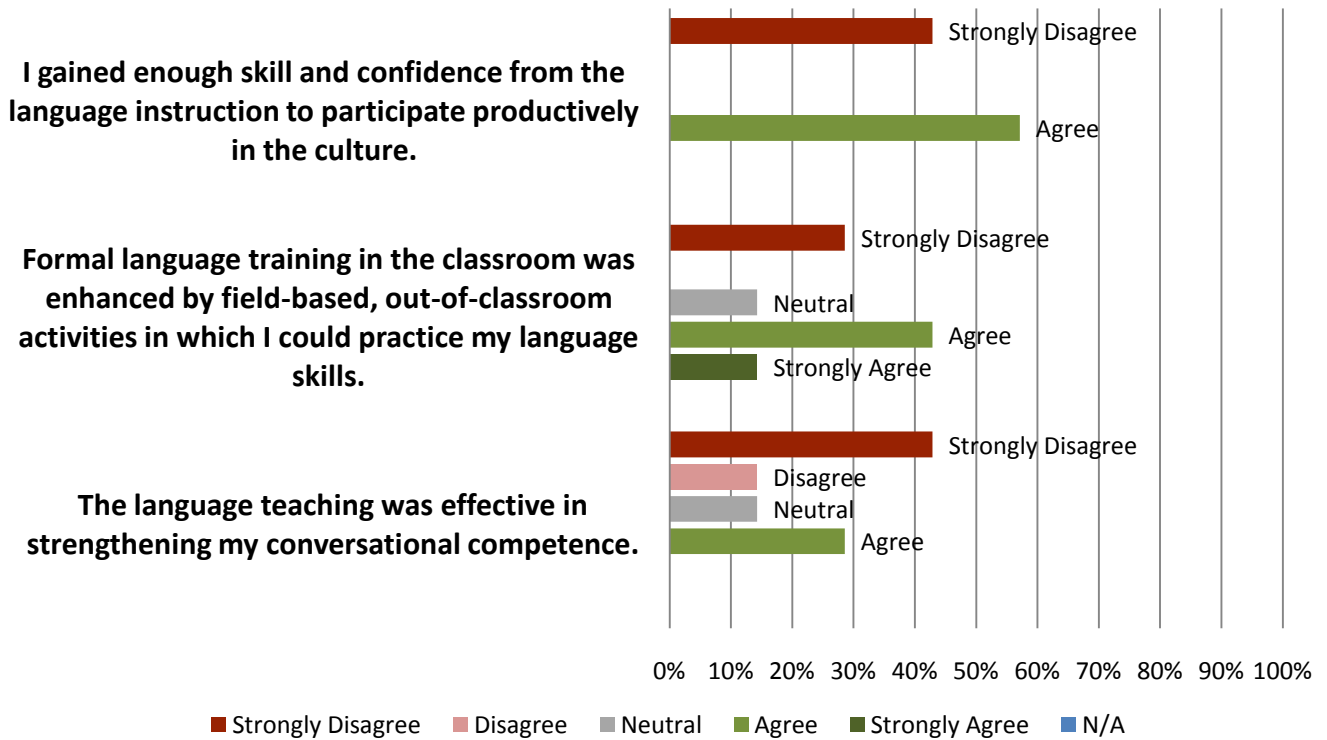
Overall Program Assessment



Overall Academic Quality

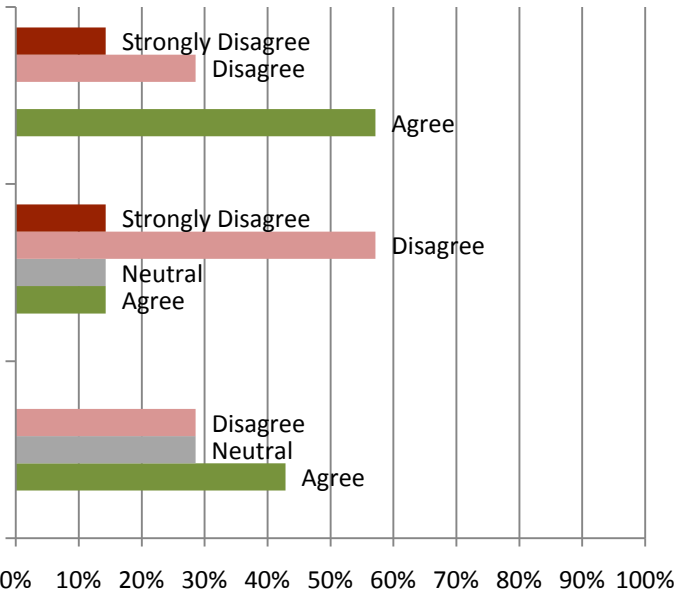

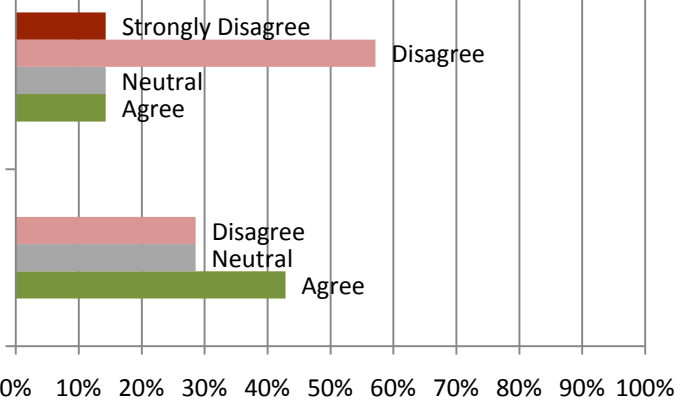

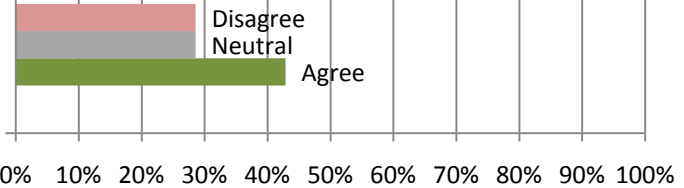
The educational excursions helped me better understand the culture of the host country and the program theme.



We reviewed and discussed the educational outcomes of the excursions in relevant debriefing and reflection sessions during the term.



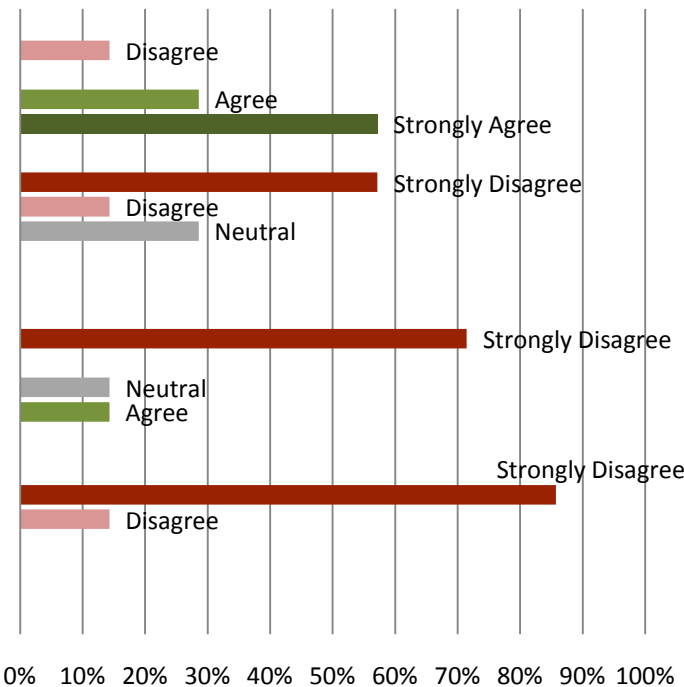

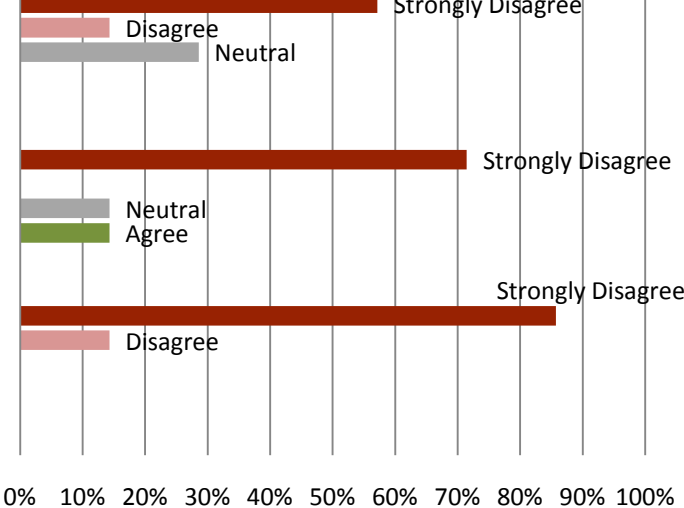

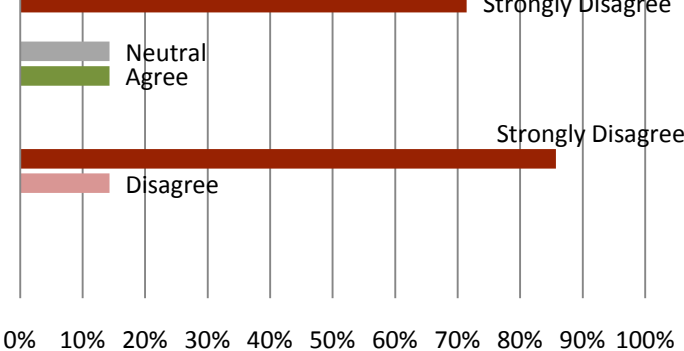
I was fully informed about SIT's Human Subjects Review Policy, the Local Review Board, and SIT's guidelines for conducting ethical research.



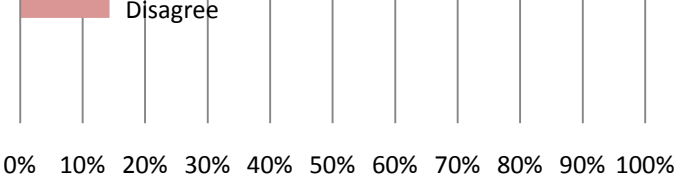
The Field Study Seminar introduced me to useful tools that helped me better navigate local cultural norms.



I used field study methods learned in this Seminar to do class assignments and conduct my Independent Study Project.

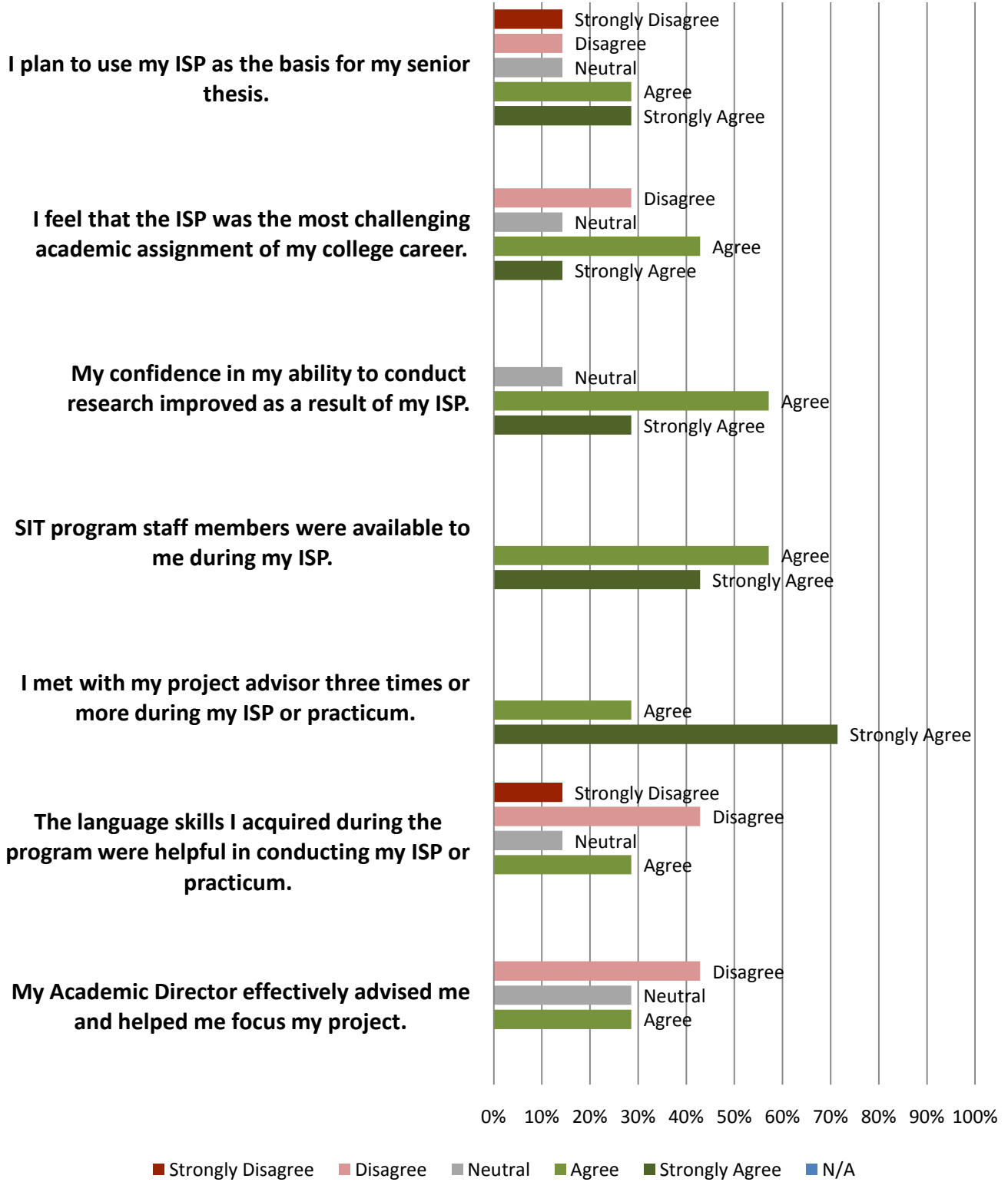
