



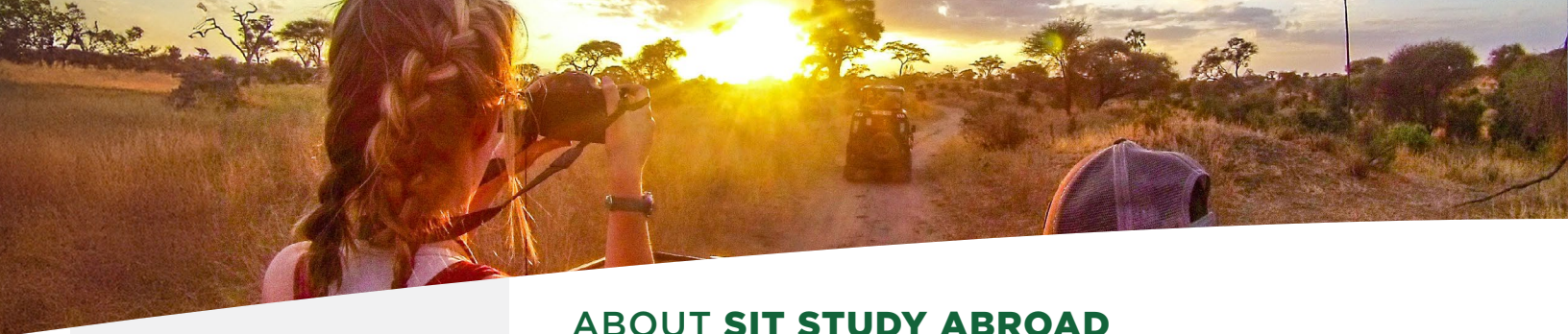

CUSTOM PROGRAM GUIDELINES

SIT seeks academic partnerships that align with our mission to prepare students to become responsible global citizens through experiential education.

In order to keep program fees affordable and facilitate cultural immersion, our partnered programs typically run for at least 10 days and enroll between 10 and 25 students. Programs must take place in countries where SIT has existing local support networks.

CUSTOM PROGRAM TIMELINE

Most custom programs run in January or in the summer term (May-August). Programs during other terms may be possible depending on the location.

We typically accept new program inquiries during the following time periods:

January Programs:

December-February of the previous academic year

Summer Programs:

April-August of the previous academic year

All other terms:

One year in advance of the anticipated program start date

TYPES OF ASSISTANCE

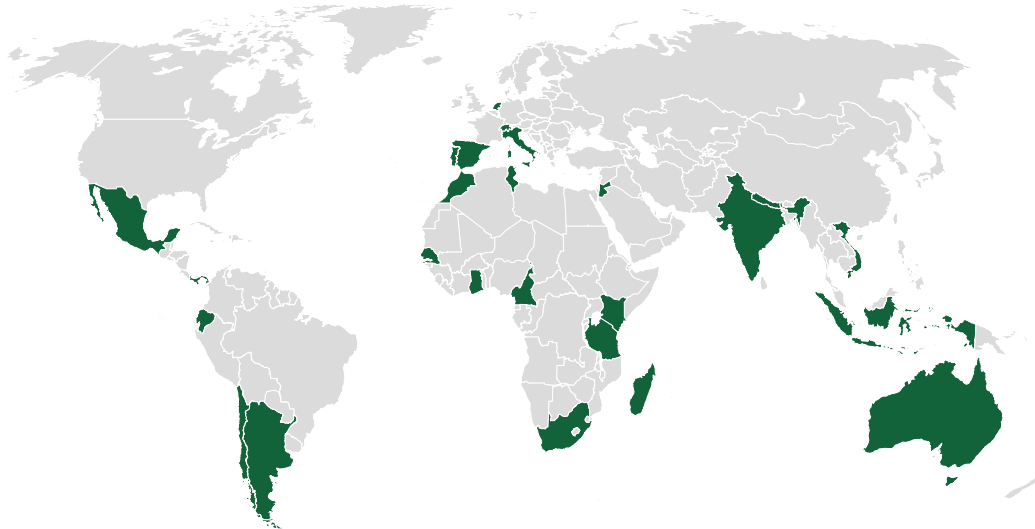
SIT takes a collaborative approach to custom program design and implementation:

ACADEMIC SUPPORT

- Curriculum and program design
- Field-based experiential learning opportunities
- In-country SIT academic directors who lead SIT's undergraduate and graduate programs
- Networks of guest lecturers and local experts for program activities
- Language instruction at various levels
- Unique cultural activities including opportunities for peer-to-peer engagement
- Community-led internships and reciprocity projects
- Fieldwork ethics and research methodology and projects
- Debrief and discussion facilitation, grounded in the Experiential Learning Cycle

LOGISTICS COORDINATION & STUDENT SUPPORT

- Pre-departure support for faculty and students, including country-specific health and safety briefings
- In-country orientations and end-of-program debriefs
- Housing and meal arrangements, including optional homestays with SIT's vetted network of trusted local families
- Classroom space at SIT program centers and other venues
- Local transportation
- Medical, evacuation, and quarantine insurance
- 24-hour on-call support with professionals from the office of SIT Student Health, Safety & Well-being and mental health counselors

CUSTOM PROGRAM LOCATIONS

Availability at our SIT program sites (*right*) depends on program dates, duration, capacity, and other factors.

CUSTOM PROGRAM MODELS

SIT works with institutions to collaboratively design, facilitate, and support programs in a variety of models for various audiences, from undergraduate and graduate students to higher education faculty and professionals.

FACULTY-LED

Co-facilitated with partner faculty leaders and SIT local program faculty/staff to support a range of course topics, disciplinary areas, and learning objectives.

SIT-LED

Co-developed with the school partner; day-to-day management of the program is provided by SIT's local program staff.

CONSORTIAL

SIT supports institutions that opt to share resources in a custom program.

INTERNSHIPS

Students are matched with local organizations and institutions that provide meaningful opportunities for hands-on learning.

FACULTY SEMINARS

Skills-based or thematic professional development seminars that include lectures, site visits, and networking with local academics for faculty or study abroad professionals.

INTENSIVE LANGUAGE

Short-term intensive study and semester-long academic instruction.

FIRST YEAR

Co-developed with the school partner, we provide courses and electives that allow students to shape their experiences while developing core college success skills. SIT First Year programs support a holistic introduction to the college experience in locations around the world.

A FRAMEWORK OF CRITICAL GLOBAL ISSUES

SIT offers institutions the opportunity to develop their custom programs around a framework of Critical Global Issues—challenges that transcend borders to touch every human on the planet.
