SIT was founded on the idea that multicultural understanding leads to positive social change. We prepare students to be interculturally effective changemakers, professionals, and citizens.


## **SUSTAINABILITY**

## **FULLY-SUPPORTED FIELD EXPERIENCE**

Independent Study Project (ISP)—With the support of SIT faculty, you will design a research project based on your interests and local resources, and work closely with an advisor and experts in the field to bring it to life.

Internship—Gain real-world experience in an international workplace, enhance your professional skills, and join the global network of community organizations, activists, entrepreneurs, business leaders, and academics connected to SIT programs.



## **ACADEMIC & CAREER IMPACT**

The knowledge, skills, and values you experience on an SIT program support your academic and career goals. Many SIT alumni join highly competitive fellowship programs, pursue advanced degrees, and go on to be changemakers in their respective fields. Alumni across the globe are working within governments and NGOs; focusing on sustainability efforts; training language teachers; responding to migration crises; confronting critical health challenges; and rebuilding the field of international education.

## **SMALL, SUPPORTIVE COHORTS**

Most SIT programs have up to 25 students from colleges and universities across the U.S. In some programs, students from the host country also join the cohort. Together, you attend lectures and field visits, and study local languages. This community of peers supports one another and enhances experiential learning through different experiences and perspectives.

## **WORLD CLASS FACULTY MEMBERS**

SIT faculty are teachers, learners, practitioners, researchers, and community members who live and work in the countries where our programs take place. Through SIT, you will experience different voices and perspectives far outside of those normally found on U.S. college and university campuses.

## SCHOLARSHIPS & GRANTS

SIT is committed to helping students from various economic backgrounds experience field-based international education. Over FY23, FY24, and FY25, we awarded nearly **\$3 million in scholarships** and grants to SIT Study Abroad students. Our scholarships are awarded to highly qualified students who demonstrate financial need. Individual awards generally range from **\$500–\$3,000 for summer programs** and up to **\$5,000 for semester programs**. The team works in partnership with program staff onsite to provide risk management, safety and security guidance, and emergency response. SIT utilizes a variety of resources to assess and respond to actual or potential risk in each country, including our international medical and security assistance provider, the U.S. Department of State, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the World Health Organization, the Overseas Security Advisory Council, and U.S. embassies.

The SHSW team also works directly with students to provide counseling, mental health support, and resources for cultural adjustment, homesickness, accessibility support, academic accommodations, international insurance, and much more.

SIT is committed to fostering a climate across all our programs that is free from discrimination, harassment, and violence. We maintain Sexual Harassment and Misconduct policies to protect and support our students. We also provide relevant training and material to in-country staff and have a dedicated Title IX Coordinator.
